

PRIVACY POLICY

Keep Akron Beautiful (KAB) is pleased to provide information to all of its customers about its online privacy policy. Please be assured that KAB uses its best efforts to protect the privacy of visitors to this web site.

Personal Information Collection and How It Is Used

KAB gathers personal information, such as first and last names, home addresses, e-mail addresses, phone numbers, and credit card numbers, only when voluntarily submitted by you. If you make an online donation, personal information will be collected from you in order to process that donation. Your first and last name and/or business name only will be listed on our website as a donor, unless otherwise requested

Only with your permission will we use personal information collected from you to send you information, such as KAB volunteer events, fundraising campaigns and our progress. You may opt out at any time.

Security of Donor Information

Donor contact information only is stored within a Microsoft Access database or Excel file within KAB. No credit numbers are stored. Credit card information for processing donations is restricted to personnel with legitimate business need to access or modify the information contained therein.

Sharing of Personal Information

Third party companies may be engaged by KAB to perform a variety of functions, such as assisting with donation collection, providing technical services for our Internet sites, etc. Such companies may have access to personal information if needed to perform certain functions. These companies may use such personal information only for the purpose of performing that function and may not use it for any other purpose.

Other than as provided in this privacy policy, KAB does not sell, transfer or disclose personal information to third parties.

KAB reserves the right to use or disclose any information as needed to satisfy any law, regulation or legal request, to protect the integrity of the site, to fulfill your requests, or to cooperate in any law enforcement investigation or an investigation on a public safety matter.

Office Databases

You are in control of all personal information you provide to us online.
